

ISO/IEC JTC 1/SC 22/WG 23 N 0173

Report of Editors' Meeting, 28 January 2009

The editorial team of ISO/IEC TR 24772 met at 10:00 am ET on 28 January 2009 via web/telecon using facilities provided by Jim Moore. Attendees were:

- John Benito (convener)
- Jim Moore (secretary)
- Clive Pygott
- Larry Wagoner

The primary intended purpose of the meeting was to discuss submissions for new material proposed for inclusion in a future draft of the technical report. Available materials were reviewed. Some editing was performed "on the fly." In general, the results were assigned to individuals in the editorial team for further rewrite. Another web/telecon for the editorial team was scheduled for Wednesday, 18 February 2009 at 10:00 am ET. Following that telecon, the editorial team will issue a report containing its recommendations for actions by the working group.

The items considered and additional details regarding their consideration are provided below:

DTK:

Jim Moore had prepared and revised a new description, DTK, based in part on the draft in N0164. The draft was reviewed and revised on-the-fly. It was decided to move the description to Clause 7. Jim was asked to revise it accordingly as well as to add cross-references. The revision will be considered in the next telecon. It was also suggested that a new three-letter-code should be assigned because DTK is the name of a computing company. John Benito will investigate.

PUS:

Dan Nagle had previously proposed PUS in document N0164. It was decided that the current draft is satisfactory. [In an email note subsequent to the meeting, Larry Wagoner suggested that the three-letter code be changed to something that is not a word. John Benito responded that he would assign a new code.]

NSQ:

Dan Nagle had previously proposed NSQ in document N0164 and had then revised it. Some editorial changes were made during the telecon and some concerns were annotated. John was asked to revise the result with the goal of differentiating it from other vulnerability descriptions related to mismatched signatures.

SLH:

Erhard Ploedereder advised the convener that he will not be able to prepare this draft.

HJW:

As requested by WG23, Clive Pygott had prepared a draft of a new vulnerability description on incomplete library specifications. It was assigned the code HJW. Some changes were made during the meeting. Clive was asked to revise the result for the next editors' telecon.
